Hope everything is going well in the new role at EPA. I have an interesting issue for you – a potential turf battle is brewing between EPA and the CPSC, the Consumer Product Safety Commission. CPSC has advanced a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to address the risk of CO emissions from portable generators when they are misused. But of course, EPA already sets standards for CO and is the expert on air emissions of this sort. CPSC is supposed to do safety, not emissions. So, we have a problem with jurisdiction. Sort of reminds one of the Hill, doesn't it?

Anyway, Ed Krenik, Jeff Holmstead and I represent the Portable Generator Manufacturers Association (PGMA). Greg Wischstadt, President of PGMA, will be in town doing meetings on this issue.
